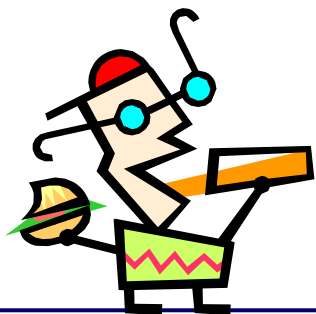
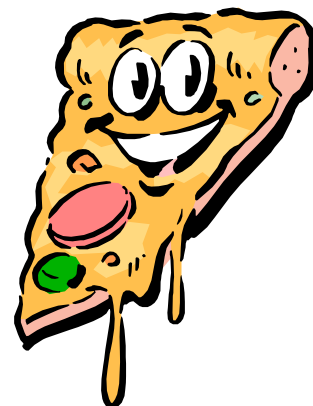
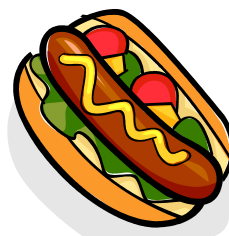

A **morning snack** is provided to all of our *junior campers* in our three, four and five year old age groups.

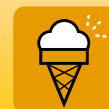
All campers will enjoy a refreshing afternoon ice-cream break.

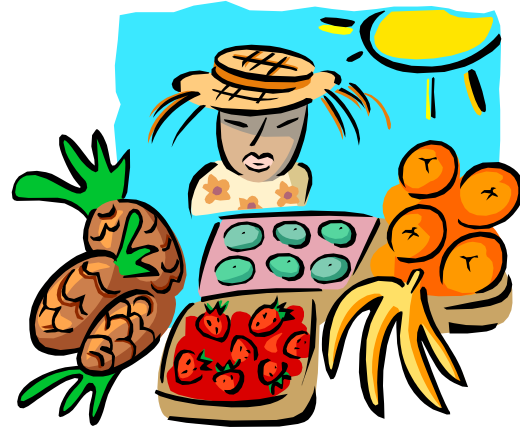

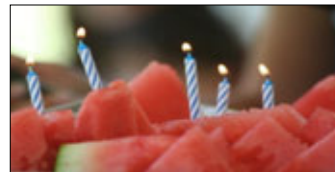
## Birthday Parties...
